DIRECTIONS and PARKING

From 210 to Presbyterian Church – Off on Towne Ave. South to Foothill. East to Mountain.
South to church, 1111 N. Mountain. Use church parking lot.

From 10 to Presbyterian Church – Off on Indian Hill. North to Harrison. West to Mountain.
North to church, 1111 N. Mountain. Use church parking lot.

From Presbyterian Church to UCC Congregational Church – South to Harrison. East to Harvard.
Sanctuary is ½ block north on Harvard. Small parking lots on Harrison, and north of the sanctuary on 6th Street. Parking also available on local streets.

From UCC Church to Thatcher Building and Bridges Hall – South on Harvard to 4th Street. East to College Ave. An easy walk from the church (campus parking may be limited).
