First Congregational Church was one of the later appointments in Fred's illustrious career. He was organist-in-residence there from 1998 to 2001 and became the church's organist-in-emeritus on retirement. The Gospel Division of The Great Organs of First Church (in the north balcony of the sanctuary) was named after him.

This celebration will include performances by Sean O'Neal (LA AGO Interim Dean), Philip Hoch (Fred Swann's last student at the University of Redlands who also succeeded



him as organist of *The Hour of Power*), and Christoph Bull (organist-in-residence at First Congregational Church).

The repertoire will include Heraldings by Robert Hebble, Introduction, Passacaglia and Fugue and Lyric Rhapsody by Searle Wright, Prelude and Fugue in C minor by Felix Mendelssohn, Johann Sebastian Bach's O Mensch, Bewein Dein Sünde Groß and Passacaglia and Fugue in C minor.

THE GREAT ORGANS

of First Congregational Church

The Great Organs housed in the cathedral-like structure of First Congregational Church are really five organs in one: the E.M. Skinner (1931) in the chancel, the Herman Schlicker (1969) in the West Gallery, Gospel and Epistle divisions in the north and south transepts, and an Italian division in the chancel. All divisions are playable from two identical, 5-manual Möller consoles in the chancel and West Gallery. The entire group of instruments consists of 328 ranks, 15 divisions, and a total of 278 speaking stops.


